Treasurer report: \$14904.31 prior to deposit of tag sale which was \$2096.68. PTO insurance was paid, the Sea Dog deposit was paid (\$100), and the Line School t-shirt order was paid.

Fall Fundraiser: Been delivered and we still have some to be sent home. If they are not picked up by conferences, they will go to the classrooms for conference night.

Trunk or Treat: Went well, there were about 300 people who attended. The expense was \$43 for candy. Mr. Stinson liked the fact it was done on Halloween, which is more convenient for families.

Tag Sale: It went well, we made a little less than last year, but overall a success. Volunteers do need to come without children when working this event.

Box Tops-We sent in about \$300 worth of Box Tops for the first round of collections. The checks will go out in December. We will also be paid for all the deposits after April of last year.

Holiday Festival: We be providing the cookies for the cookies with Santa. The cookies need to be here. December 2nd-Friday by 1-2pm. If you can't get the cookies here then please donate them directly to LFD. Melissa will create a flyer for this event.

Scholastic Dollars: Mr. Stinson would like to use the Scholastic dollars to purchase a display case for the Maker Space at Line. It is a wooden book display that would have STEM based books on display. It costs \$199.00. Kris Wescott made a motion to approve, Maryanne Baker seconded it, all approved.

Playground Funds: The toys have been upgraded as well as the basketball backboards. The monkey bars have been taken out due to injuries. In the future we may be looking to replace that. The climbing wall grips need to be replaced. There are two quotes for them due to weathering and use. Motion was made to approve the \$2,365.70 by Melissa Knight, seconded by Brenda Wedgewood, all approved.

School Dance Information: Heather can make a proposal and present the costs and organizational structure of the event. A suggestion was made that "admission" be a small donation to the PTC or a food item to the school food bank.

New Business/Suggestions: Fundraiser survey-Melissa Knight will put that together and send to Tim. Kris Wescott will look at possibly changing the Square 1 art products. Check with Martha to see if it would work with her schedule. Last year Square 1 Art raised \$1231.
