

PTC Meeting Minutes – January 10, 2019

Attendees: Brenda Wedgewood, Jere Gray, Kristen Carll, Lisa Burgess & Anastasia Ferguson

Jere Gray Made a motion to approve November Meeting Minutes, Brenda Wedgewood 2nd the motion. All were in favor.

Treasurer Report: The report will be delayed as the treasurer was out on a leave. The balance as of today (1/10/19) is \$8,064.31. A more detailed report will be at the next meeting.

Pasta Love Around will happen again this year. It will be on Wednesday, February 6th and Thursday, February 7th. The time will be determined. Brenda Wedgewood, Lyn Eaton and Wanda Johnson will run this on behalf of the staff. PTC will fund this event, in the past it cost us \$270.23, not sure if this includes the \$50 gift certificate for Lucille as she needs to be present for this event to run. Jere Gray motioned for Pasta Love Around funds for up to \$300. Lisa Burgess 2nd the motion. All were in favor. PTC will also work with Stephanie Lettelier and Kyla Aucion to have classrooms involved in a school wide food drive. Each class will be assigned a different item, with the understanding that if a family can not afford an item assigned to their student's class, they can donate other non-perishable items.

Craft/Vendor Fair will take place this year. We will run this event on Saturday, May 4th from 9am-2pm. Brenda Wedgewood will run this event with the assistance of Jere Gray and Anastasia Ferguson as well as any other PTC members, staff and parents who'd like to volunteer their time. More information will go out soon to let vendor's crafters know we will be doing the fair this year, so they can sign up.

Scholastic Book Fair – This will be the Week of April 29th – May 3rd. We will hold the fair on Tuesday, April 30, Wednesday, May 1 and Thursday, May 2nd. Family night will be on May 1st from 5:30-7pm. We will offer Title I to join in as with the grouping it seems to help bring the families in. This fair will also be a BOGO fair. The theme is Dinosaurs.

5th Grade Field Trip – Lisa Burgess presented on behalf of the 5th grade teachers. The field trip will take place at Camp Cody, the outdoor classroom again this year. It will be on May 17th. The trip will cost about \$2,700.00 for the entire trip with buses. Deposit of \$10 per student is needed prior to February 1st, with full balance by May 7th. If we have any students who do not end up making the field trip after it is paid, we will be reimbursed for them not attending. Brenda Wedgewood made a motion to approve full funds for the 5th grade field trip. Jere Gray 2nd the motion. All were in favor.

Valentine's Craft and Cookie Decorating Night – We will not do this event this year.

Read A Thon – We will plan to do this in February, have students go home with a packet to describe and record minutes and sponsors information. We will do the read a thon reading minutes February 25 – March 1st. This will be a full PTC fundraiser with all profit. We will reward 1 student from each class K-5 for up to \$10 book from Scholastic that the student will pick out and we will order. We can also have Tim Stinson do a drop everything and read, use library time to read, use 2nd step time to read as well as what students read at home during this week.

Dr. Suess Show and Prism Light Show – Research both of these for cost to see if we can do one of these this year or next year. These shows will replace the Hamstead Stage Company performances. Present with these in February.

Family Night – this was tabled until February. We are looking at Maine Mariners Hockey, Portland Red Claws Basketball, Maine Mammoths Indoor Arena Football, and a Smitty’s movie Fundraiser too. These will all be presented at the next meeting in February.
