Library Digital magazines for Students – Michelle Stosze; Looking for magazine subscriptions for the library and some home use \$14-\$20 subscriptions for costs for each one, to have variety for some students to be more involved in literary materials. Highlights, Gamer & Sport magazines were suggested. Motion to approve \$100.00 by Patricia, 2nd by Shirley, all were in favor.

Also proposed author visits through scholastic and other various options for the future, Michelle will work with Tim to look at options for this.

DownEast Clynck Challenge – Clynk for Schools Recycling challenge Jan 29 – Mar 26, every \$1 raised during this challenge period, schools will get an additional 50 cents match plus opportunity to compete for cash prizes. Last year schools raised an average of \$1,500.00 All schools in K-12 private and public are eligible in Maine and NY, with a 25-mile radius of a clynk drop location. Will soon be in PTC name. 5th Grade Field Trip – Deposit of \$100.00 needed for Cody Outdoor Classroom, 5th Grade Teachers will come to the February meeting to discuss the trip in more detail. Questions about their transportation and if any additional teachers will be attending were raised. Will follow up with the teachers on these questions.
