Read A Thon packets/money was picked up on Friday 3/6 and Tim asked that we extend the pick up for students as we have had a number of students out with illnesses. We will have the remainder of the packets due this Friday, March 13, 2020. As of now we have collected \$1,972 for the read a thon. About half of what we brought in last year. An additional count of remaining packets will be done after any remaining packets are picked up.

Craft/Vendor Fair it was decided that we will not do this event this year. We will look at doing possibly next year.

Book Fair is scheduled for April 28<sup>th</sup> to April 30<sup>th</sup> with Family Night on Wednesday, April 29<sup>th</sup>. The Theme is Jungle, Elephants, Tigers & Books OH MY!! We will keep an eye on what the state and the Covid-19 is in the upcoming month as to what this will hold. A lot of other book fairs have been cancelled throughout the country.

Sweet Treats Event at this time with the district cancelling outside groups and events in the district, we feel we should follow suit with the district guidelines and cancel this event at this time.

Booster Thon at this time we will not do this type of event. It is a lot of money to put up front for no guarantee that we will get a lot of profit from this company. We will look at other options to do a

possible athon for a charity that the funds go directly to a charity/cause for the PTC to give back to an organization.

Limerick Block Party that is being held this summer at this present time we do not have enough members to be able to support helping with this event. We would love to be able to do this, but with not a lot of parents being able to help us during the school year, there is not much chance we can get their support during the summer.

Buddy Bags for Pre-K and K. Mrs. Winn has asked for some volunteers and PTC to do a flier(s) for the buddy bags. PTC will do some PTC related information as well as provide Mrs. Winn in the office with some support in getting the buddy bags ready for the screenings for the Pre-K and K days in May.

PTC Closet Paper Products we will keep an eye on the products for the upcoming events, like staff week, muffins with mom and donuts with dad, 5<sup>th</sup> grade recognition. We will get what we need as we need them.

Fall Fundraiser we will stick with Meadow Farms fundraiser as it is simple and it ships directly to the student's homes. We will not do the school store at the present time.

April Meeting will be nominations for PTC Officers. Nominations for President, Vice President, Treasurer, Recording Secretary, Corresponding Secretary, & Bulletin Board Coordinator. In May voting will take place on these positions for positions to start in June. New positions will need to be specified in Meeting Minutes as the new role of President will need to be presented to the bank so that Anastasia can be removed from the bank account and the New President can be added with the Treasurer as per the By-Laws. By-Laws do not state how many officers we need to have in office, if we do not have a Vice President, it was stated that another member or school personal like Tim Stinson or Christina Winn could assist with signing off on our bank and record keeping books to be partial.
