

Line PTC meeting on Zoom - Ammended Meeting Minutes
September 24, 2020 7 PM

Call to order 7:03 PM by Jere Gray, president.

Kayla Robinson seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Jere Gray will reach out to Tim Stinson and Linda Palmer about ordering. Pam Beaulieu volunteered to coordinate purchasing within the school as others are not allowed inside the school at this time.

Brenda Wedgewood received a phone call from the Research Committee in Limerick. They would like to donate some funds to us. Brenda was wondering if these funds could be used to support the Line School food pantry. Perhaps we could buy Hannaford gift cards for families. Brenda will connect with Deneane Neyer, Stephanie Letellier and Tim Stinson about the possibility and details.
